Subject:- Haryana Government Employees Group Insurance Scheme,
1985 - Increase in the rate of subscription and
corresponding insurance cover by 50% with effect from
1st January, 1990.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to Rules 5(1) and 7(1) of Notification dated 20.8.1985 (Haryana Government Employees Group Insurance Scheme, 1985) wherein it has been laid down that the subscription for the Scheme would be in the units of Rs 10/- per month and that the amount of insurance cover would be Rs 10,000/- for each unit of subscription.

2. A proposal for increasing the rates of subscription and the corresponding insurance cover under the Group Insurance Scheme was under consideration of the State Government. Now, it has been decided in modification of the provisions of Rules 5(1) and 7(1) of Notification dated 20.8.1985 *ibid*, that the subscription for the scheme shall be in the units of Rs 15/- per month and the amount of insurance cover shall be Rs 15,000/- for each unit of subscription with effect from 1st January, 1990.

3. It has also been decided that the existing compulsory New Group Insurance Scheme as such should continue for all the employees as hithertofore and the subscription at the enhanced rate of 50% be made optional for all employees of 'D', 'C', 'B' and 'A' categories with effect from 1.1.1990. In case of Class IV Govt. employees whose subscription of Rs 10/- per month is being paid by the State Government, ^{would} continue to be paid as hithertofore, but the increase of Rs 5/- for a unit will not be paid by Government. They will have to subscribe this additional subscription of Rs 5/- per month themselves, if they opt for the enhanced rate of subscription.

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4. In order to implement the above decision of Govt., the employees are required to exercise their option by 31st October, 1989 and the option once exercised will be treated as final and no further choice will be available and the employees who do not exercise their option within the prescribed period shall be deemed to be the member of the new Scheme on the revised enhanced rates. Those employees who join service after the last date of exercising the option, be given three months to exercise their option from their date of joining Government service for adopting the revised rate of subscription.


5. Those employees who join service after the date of issue of this letter till 31.12.1989 shall be governed by the provision of the Rule 6 of the Rules issued vide Notification dated 30.3.1985.

6. You are, therefore, requested that the contents of this letter may kindly be brought to the notice of all employees of the Haryana State and within the Departments under your administrative control.

7. Necessary amendment in the relevant rules will be made in due course.

8. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Department conveyed vide their U.O. No. 3(13)-3FG-II-88/2135 dated 7.9.1989.
